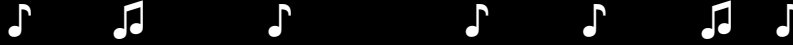




Kid's Summer Art Camp 2010

Enroll your children in the **Oak Park Arts District's Art Camp** and give them the opportunity to expand their art skills with professional artists through dance and movement, mixed-media, glasswork, beading, painting, culinary arts, fiber arts, print-making, yoga and more.

BEAD IN HAND Julia Schaefer, a multi-media artist, has been running children's classes and birthday parties since she started working at Bead in Hand in 2000. Students will learn age appropriate beading skills and create a variety of beaded projects.

INTUIT DANCE INTUIT Dance director, **Diane VanDerhei**, has created a curriculum that develops dance technique while engaging imaginations and creativity through music and movement.

EXPRESSIONS GRAPHICS Printmaker and artist, **Janet Schill**, has experience in woodblock, linoleum, etching, and screen printing. Students will learn a variety of fun printmaking techniques.

MAGICAL MINDS STUDIO Owner and artist **Haj Herbert** will provide a unique and artful experience for young creative minds. Children will be exposed to various techniques such as printing, watercolor, painting, tie dying and sculpture, with an emphasis on recycled materials.

HENDERSON FUSED GLASS **Laura Henderson** has been working with fused glass since 2002. Students will learn fusing fundamentals and make a project that combines color and texture into a unique glass piece.

BUZZ CAFÉ **Laura Maychruk**, founder of Buzz Café, mother of 4 and life-long cook with a passion for homemade, delicious, healthy foods with a gourmet flair and **Veronica Brend**, Chef at Buzz Café, and a graduate of Illinois Institute of Art-Chicago will be exploring various cooking and baking techniques with an emphasis on hands-on fun! We will make kid favorites with seasonal ingredients fresh from the farm

WHISPERS FROM THE MOON **Ellen Gradman**, arts educator, artist, teacher, thinker, and connector of people and ideas encourages everyone to join the journey and will be igniting the spark of creativity in each child in a fun and unique format.

VAL'S HALLA Working with professional music instructor, **Amy Shropshire**, students will learn & rehearse a group of songs (instruments & vocal). The final session will be the "recording studio". Each child will bring home a CD of their musical creation!

PAMELA PENNEY TEXTILE ARTS Textile and fiber artist, **Pamela Penney**, has been teaching the fun of fiber to children and adults for over 20 years. Kids will learn fun techniques to use fabric, yarn and fiber to create a unique textile art piece.

CALYPSO MOON **Sallie Wolf** is a watercolor artist, teacher and author of several children's books. Multi-media artist, painter and teacher, **Jennifer Tiner**, is currently attending SAIC and has been teaching children for several years. Sallie and Jenny will be teaching age appropriate drawing, painting and collage during the program

STUDIO LIGHT Visual artist and writer, **Karen Light**, an experienced art teacher with Urban Gateways, strives to teach students more about themselves and the world through engaging, creative art-making. Projects will be mixed-media and multi-dimensional marvels!

CREATIVE CHANGES Through process painting with **Terry Mueller**, who has been teaching since 2003, kids will have access to a rainbow of paints, assortment of brushes and will be allowed to express themselves without pressure or expectation. Children will bring home paintings and a sense of creative freedom.

KINGFISH STUDIO **Dave King**, glass artist and owner of House of Heat has been working with glass for the past eight years and looks forward to sharing his enthusiasm for the craft. Children will use glass and their creativity to make their own artistic kaleidoscope and more!

ART GECKO, LTD. Mixed Media artist and owner, **Lisa Nordstrom** has been creating eco-friendly art since childhood. Students will get a chance to use some really fun tools and gadgets to learn a few different types of bookbinding techniques to create artsy, one-of-a-kind journals or memory books.

YOGA TREK CENTER **Kate Wester** hopes to convey a sense of self-care and self-acceptance, equanimity, and the development of moment to moment awareness to children through yoga. **Alison Welch** is a former gymnast and marathoner and has found her physical and spiritual "home" through practicing and teaching yoga.

Children will visit a variety of studio/galleries during the 2-week session for art lessons and will be escorted between locations by the instructors. The class schedule will be sent out a few weeks before camp starts. Please note that your child may not visit all of the above studios, but a variety of at least 10 depending upon the dates and times they have registered for.
